SCHOOL UNIFORM.

1. The wearing of School Uniform is obligatory during school time (including to and from School) and at all functions and activities which are in any way connected with the School. If the uniform is worn out of school hours it must be complete.

It consists of:-

Blazer, with metal House badge only. (House badges obtainable at the School in term).

School Cap. Vlth Formers only are exempt from wearing the School cap.

School Tie.

Plain, mid-grey flannel or worsted trousers. Long trousers should not be worn by boys below the 111rd Form.

Plain mid-grey socks with long trousers; plain mid-grey stockings with school colour tops with short trousers.

Plain black shoes. Wellingtons may not be worn inside the school. With School uniform, only the school scarf and mid-grey V neck pullover may be worn.

Navy blue macs, double-breasted and with all-round belt. Navy blue duffle coats, although not desirable, will be tolerated.

2. No employment may be undertaken without the Headmaster's permission.
3. For such employment no item of uniform bearing School colours may be worn.

SPORTS WEAR.

4. P.T. and Athletics: White singlet, white shorts, white ankle socks, white plimsolls.
5. Football: House shirt, House stockings, black shorts, boots.
6. Cricket: Members of School XI's. White shirt, long white flannels, white socks, cricket boots, pullover (either all white or white with school colours).  
Others. White shirt. Cricket boots and pullover (either all white or white with school colours) are advisable.

HOUSE COLOURS

Stone House : Red and White.  
Fisher : Blue and White.  
More : Black and White.

## PERSONAL PROPERTY.

7. All items of clothing, all footwear and, wherever possible, all other personal belongings must be clearly and permanently marked with the owner's surname in full and at least one initial or Christian name. Articles not so marked may not be kept on the school premises.
8. The School will not be responsible for property not so marked nor for property left on the premises out of term.
9. The loss of any article must be reported immediately to the Prefect of Discipline, the Sports Master or the School Captain.
10. Sports shirt, vest and shorts must be kept in a cloth bag hung in the cloakroom and marked with the owner's name.
11. Borrowing and lending are strictly forbidden.
12. All queries concerning school wear must be referred to the Prefect of Discipline.
